Preparing Your Child

Allow Ample Opportunity to Play

When your child is playing, your child is learning.
"Play is their work."



Develop Vocabulary and Language Skills

- Have frequent conversations "Tell me more..."
 - Model and encourage listening behaviors.
- Read to your child daily and TALK about the books.

"Reading aloud to children early in life rapidly develops their language skills."





















Preparing Your Child

Develop Motor Skills

- Build hand strength (Cut, color, draw, build, paint, playdough)
- Build body strength (Play outside, jump, roll, throw, skip, hop, catch, climb)

Develop Independence Skills

 Practice personal self care (Toileting, dressing and changing shoes, opening food containers)

Develop Cooperation Skills

 Group interactions (Sharing, turn taking, cooperation, managing frustration, using kind words)




















Preparing Your Child

Develop Literacy Skills

Read aloud to your child daily.

Children need to hear 1000 stories before they learn to read themselves.



Develop Numeracy Skills

Use math language – colour/size/shape/numbers.
Play math games – dice/card games.














Bus Information

- Please attach bus information on outside of bookbag using a luggage tag.






















Safe Arrival

- Documentation is needed for all medication to be given at school.






















Immunizations (
