



This is a summary of vaccines that will be offered by public health to middle and high school students in New Brunswick in 2014-2015. These vaccines are given to school age children through school based immunization clinics held at all middle and high schools.

### Grade 7

#### Adacel vaccine

- This vaccine offers protection against tetanus, diphtheria, and pertussis (whooping cough)

### Grade 7 Females

Gardasil vaccine helps to protect against infection caused by 4 types of Human Papillomavirus (HPV). These types of HPV infection are responsible for most cervical cancer cases in Canada.

Gardasil vaccine is given in three doses;

First dose: At chosen date.

Second dose: 2 months after the first dose.

Third dose: 6 months after the first dose.

### Grade 9

#### Menveo vaccine

- The quadrivalent conjugate vaccine (Menveo) offers protection against Meningococcal Disease, serogroups A, C, Y and W-135.
