GUIDELINES

Robert Morimanno passed away in October 2019, at the age of 51, from brain cancer. He loved life and was passionate about giving back to his community, whether it was volunteering on boards, teaching fitness classes at the YMCA and Goodlife clubs, coaching youth soccer with the Fredericton District Soccer Association, or teaching cross country skiing with the Wostawea club.

Robert built numerous life-long friendships, always making a point of putting others at ease and leaving them with a kind word and a smile. "Try to leave them smiling," was his modus operandi (M.O.). To create a lasting memorial to Robert, family, friends, and organizations have donated to the Robert Morimanno Memorial Scholarship Fund.

Available Scholarships:

Two \$500 scholarships will be awarded each year, to one male and one female soccer player in their high school graduating year, attending one of the four local area high schools: École Sainte-Anne (ESA), Fredericton High School (FHS), Leo Hayes High School (LHHS) and Oromocto High School (OHS). Students must be in grade 12 and be accepted to a publicly funded post-secondary institution.

Program Guidelines & Selection Criteria:

Seeking graduating students who played soccer for their respective high school during their graduating year at ESA, FHS, LHHS or OHS. They should have a record of volunteering in the community in non-school sponsored activities. Applicants must have a minimum high school average of 75%. Scholarships will be paid before the first day of class in September 2021.

Applicants will be required to submit the following:

- 1. A current curriculum vitae.
- 2. A 250-500 word written essay on the importance of lifelong learning.
- 3. A letter of acceptance from a public post-secondary institution.
- 4. A school transcript.
- 5. A letter of endorsement from their respective coach or athletic director.

The application deadline is **midnight April 30, 2021**, to be received by the Fredericton Community Foundation by email (<u>info@fredfdn.ca</u>). Please indicate the "Robert Morimanno Memorial Scholarship Fund Application" in the subject line.

Applications will be reviewed, and recipients will be selected by a committee consisting of volunteers and Laura Davey.
