4. Student Hunger completed their video for October featuring Liverpool Students.

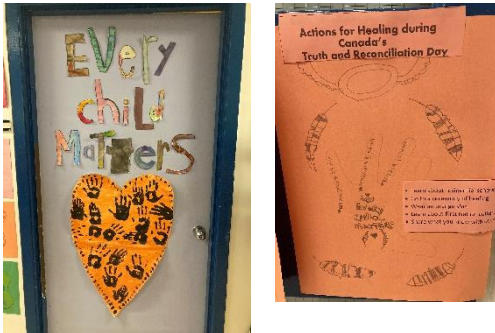
