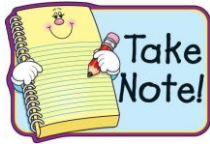

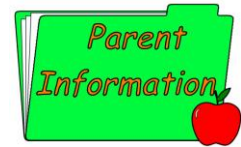
The Parent School Support Committee will meet on Tuesday, May 7th at 6:15 pm. This is our final PSSC meeting for the school year.
