Food Drive



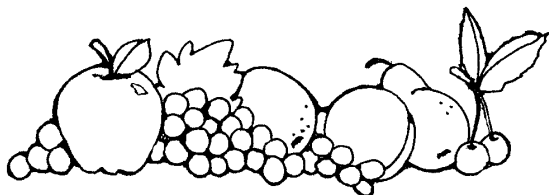
