- Principal Updates:

o School Improvement Plan - 2 big goals for the year. The first goal is a combination of 2 of our previous plan. Goal 1 is a focus on mental fitness and resilience. Goal 2 focuses on Math and Literacy scores.

Goal 1 - Mindful Mondays — videos that we share with students in the morning on Monday to start the week off right. So far we have focused on breathing techniques for students to use in self-calming. We also use the WITS program to help students build independence with conflict resolution and understanding the difference between conflict and bullying.
