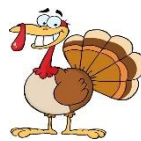
## IT'S ALL ABOUT SAFETY!

## Halloween Safety Tips!



**Do not use masks.** Masks make it hard for children to see what's around them, including cars.

**Try a hypoallergenic** (less likely to cause an allergic reaction), non-toxic make-up kit instead.

**Make or buy costumes** in light-coloured material. Place strips of reflective tape on the back and front of costumes, so that drivers can better see your child. Costumes should fit properly to prevent trips and falls.

**Avoid items** such as oversized shoes, high heels, long dresses and long capes. Dress your child for the weather. Add layers if needed put your child's name, address and phone number on his costume.

**Children under 10** should be accompanied by an adult for trick or treating. By the age of 10, some children are ready to go trick-or-treating with a group of friends.

### If your child is going out without an adult:















1. Make sure your child is in a group of at least 3 people.
2. Give them a flashlight. A cell phone is also a good idea if you have one.
3. Set a curfew (and make sure they have a watch with them).
4. Tell your children not to eat anything until they get home.
