Parents are reminded to sign in at the office when entering the school, and to **call to advise the school** if your child is absent or running late on a particular day. *(As per the NB Education Act, we require a signed written excuse upon their return. PH: 784 – 6808)*

Also if you drive your children to school, please do not pull into the parking lot to drop them off.

This is a very congested area and poses a safety concern to others when you do not follow protocol by dropping them off along Rose Street at the crosswalk. There is a crosswalk guard on duty to assist students crossing the road. If your child rides the bus, and is a K-2 student, parents / guardians are reminded that they must meet the bus at their afternoon bus stop. **As well, if your K-2 child rides the bus in the morning please remember to wait with them to ensure the bus arrives to pick them up. (this is true even at the High School bus stop.)** Unfortunately the bus does breakdown at times and there are unforeseen situations.
