Communication:

- School connects messages sent via email on a regular basis.

Hot lunch/ Money:

- Monday (Pita Pit- cheque made out to 649411 nb inc.), Tuesday (Papa Johns check made out to Montgomery Street School) and Thursday (Great Canadian Bagel cheque made out to Great Canadian Bagel).
- Please be mindful of what order you are paying for and make the cheque out to the appropriate company.
- Please pay for each of your children separately, according to their class. Please do not send in money for all the children to one teacher.
- Teachers cannot make change so please use cheques (preferable) or pay with the exact amount of cash for hot lunch, school fees, etc.

- No late orders can be accepted.
- School Cancellations: Great Canadian Bagel will have their lunch on Friday; Papa John's will extend the order by a week as does Pita Pit.
- Send all money directly to your child's teacher, not the office.
- We try as best as we can to simplify accounting so that teachers can focus on teaching and lesson planning.

Fundraising

- We typically have one large fundraising event in the fall where we fundraise for a specific outcome (technology, smart boards, playground improvements etc.)
- Occasionally throughout the year we raise small amounts of money through such things as popcorn sales, milk and hot lunch sales. These funds raised are used for

- the students for such things as whole school BBQ's, events, school performances, field trips etc.
- We have just been informed Ford is partnering with the school for the Ford Test drive event next Saturday, the 17th! Every test drive will earn the school \$20.00. More details will follow on Monday but plan to pop onto the school next Saturday morning!

School hours

- First drop off, 7:50 at the earliest.
- School begins at 8:10, your child is tardy past 8:15, please make every attempt to have your child to school on time.
- Grades K-2 finish at 2:00 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday.
- Grades 3-5 finish at 2:50 on Monday, Tuesday, Thursday and Friday
- All classes dismiss at 12:00pm on Wednesday.
- Recess 10:20 10:40, noon recess 12:25 12:55.
- When picking up students, parents wait in the lobby; students will come to the lobby at dismissal. This helps reduce noise at 2pm dismissal and reduce traffic in the hallway at Wednesday's dismissal.

Rise-n-shine

- **❖** Early morning sports program that runs from 7:30 − 8:10.
- Monday, Tuesday and Wednesday.
- Grades 3-5 students (some exceptions can be made if you have another child in grade two and need to drop off both children at 7:30, please contact us).
- Please arrive at 7:30 and no earlier.
- Begins Monday, September 12th.

Traffic Flow

- Morning drop off occurs at the top left roadway by the portable.
- Buses drop off at the top right portable.
- "Kiss-n-go" drop off please to ensure quick traffic flow in the morning.
- Students should <u>not</u> be dropped off by the front door; it is dangerous with buses and cars travelling up the roadway.
- A teacher is on duty until 8:10 at the top of the roadway by the portable, at the 8:10 bell they must leave and attend to their students.

Breakfast program

- A simple food option is available for students who did not have time to eat breakfast; we offer yogurt, cheese, cereal and seasonal fruit.
- A grade five student group visits all classes by 8:20 with a basket and students may choose an item to eat.
- Beginning when the milk program begins.

Allergies:

- We are a scent free environment and do have a staff member with severe allergies to scents.
- Two classes are considered to be a nut free zone (1 Chisholm and 1 Eroh), all other classes are free to bring nut products to school.
- Students are to wash their hands and avoid sharing food products in their classes.

Popcorn Friday:

- Students can buy popcorn on Fridays for \$1.
- Students bring their loonie on Fridays.
- An email will be sent home to let you know when popcorn Friday begins.

Visiting the School:

- Visitors must report to the office upon arrival.
- We discourage visitors to classrooms to avoid disrupting the learning environment.
- Should you need to pick your child up early, we will call them to the office when you arrive.
