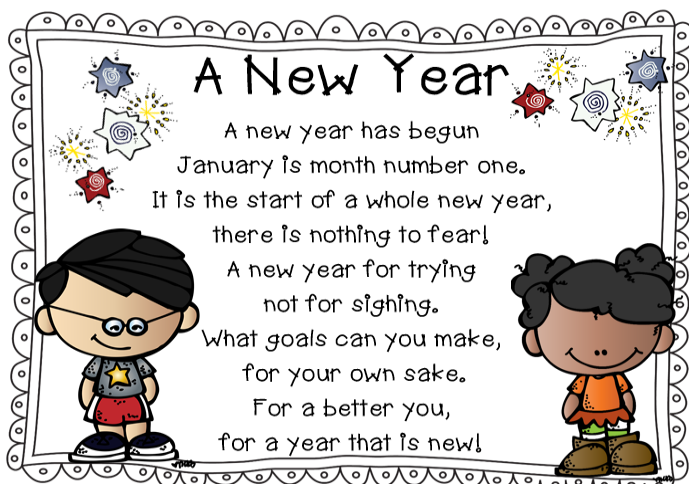
Montgomery Street School students, teachers and parents are so **thankful** for all of our wonderful **sponsors** who are

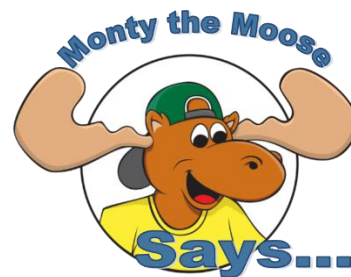
