Meeting was called to order at 6:05pm.

Marla asked to add "Student Backpacks" to the agenda. All were in favour. Stacey moved to approve the Agenda. Andrea H seconded.

Andrea C moved to approve the Minutes from the previous meeting. Andrea H seconded.

Elections

By acclamation, Jeanette Garland was elected as Chairperson, and Anna MacFarlane as Secretary. Handbooks and a copy of the Education Act was given to the new members and Jeanette advised that if they would like orientation she would assist with getting that for them.

Business arising from the Minutes

The tentative 2020/21 PSSC meeting schedule is as follows; Sept 24th, Nov 24th, Jan 19th, Mar 16th, and May 18th; all Tuesday nights at 6pm, at NHS.

New Business

Sean reported that the Virtual Open House/parent information meeting took place on Sept 10th, using ZOOM, and is currently available for viewing on the school website.

Sean presented the School Improvement Plan (SIP) draft in a revised, easy to follow format, as well as the School Funds Report. The final SIP will be approved in November. It was mentioned that new supportive initiatives are being carried out this semester by staff at NHS in response to the Our School SEL data collected from students, where increased numbers of NHS students are reporting high levels of anxiety and depression.

Communications between the school and parents will be taking place by email and phone messaging. Social media channels will also be used, such as Facebook, Twitter, and Instagram.

Jeanette reported that the current balance of the PSSC 2020-21 budget year is \$830.44.

Due to Covid-19, there will be no international students attending NHS this semester. There are 4 families interested in hosting students at NHS, and the school will continue to follow developments with this program as the Covid-19 situation evolves.

NHS currently has 268 students attending (around the same as last year), and 19.75 teacher positions. Due to Covid-19, extra hours have been added to the total Custodian hours.

Upcoming Parent Teacher dates are Nov 19th and Nov 20th, both taking place virtually by phone or on-line.

School pictures will take place on Sept 30th and Oct 1st.

Grade 9 student vaccinations will be carried out on Nov 6th and 9th.

The current Fundraising Events are a Tupperware sale by the Grad Class, and a Basket Raffle (for Christmas) by the Prom Committee.

Bell Schedule has been changed by 5 minutes to help with the wait time of the buses for the students in the afternoon. Was 3:15 now 3:10.

Exam Schedule – Semester 1 – there may be some changes, as the week does not give enough time to bring in the Day 1 and Day 2 students.

A discussion was held regarding the students no longer being able to use their lockers, resulting in them carrying extremely heavy book bags throughout each day, containing valuable items such as lap tops, Ipads, phones, etc... Suggestions were made to potentially have a drop off classroom for students to use.


Correspondence
