Influenza school surveillance: Please complete the [Influenza Reporting Form](#). See Appendix B of the [Public Health Communicable Resource for Educators](#). Fax the form to Fredericton Public Health office 506-444-4877 in the following situations:

- the daily absenteeism rate is greater than 10% and is most likely due to influenza symptoms or;
- the daily absenteeism is higher by 5% or more than the previous week's rate and it is most likely due to children experiencing influenza symptoms .
