Literacy	
Our theme this month is " Les métiers et les professions".	
Vocabulary/ Sentence structures (In class)	Qui travaille dans la communauté?/ Who works in the community? <ul style="list-style-type: none">- un enseignant / a teacher- un charpentier / a carpenter- Un pompier / a firefighter <p>...travaille dans la communauté. / works in the community.</p>
Sound of the Week (In class)	Er/ ez/ ai (é) – Émilie Éléphante (Émilie the Elephant) Will we learn that er/ ez and ai also make the sound (é).Throughout the week we will explore a variety of words and put them into context through reading, writing and speaking activities.
Sight words (In class)	Jouer, sa, donner, pas, ami
Homework	You can continue working with your child on sight words; being able to recognize the words quickly. For pronunciation please use the audio in the power point 'Sight words flash 6'. Also please continue reading with your child in French or English every night for 15 minutes.

In class this week and at home:

Mathematique	
Numeracy	<p>We will continue to work on understanding that a number (the whole) can be broken into parts and putting these parts together is called addition. We will practice solving number stories and writing a number sentence to match.</p> <p><u>Example of a number story:</u> There were 5 frogs in a pond, 4 more hopped in. How many frogs are in the pond now. <u>Example of a number sentence:</u> $5+4=9$</p> <p>Over the next two weeks we will learn to use a variety of tools to solve addition number stories (ten frames, tally marks, pictures, materials and number line). We will also be exposing students to personal problem solving strategies (Counting on, doubles, one more/one less).</p>
Homework	<p>I will send home a 'bleu duotang' for show your work.</p> <p>Student can show what they have been working on in class. Please sign it and return it to school by friday.</p>
