

Grade 1 Newsletter September – Mrs. Lyons



We will be working on the following outcomes this month:

Literacy:

Reading:

We will review and learn many new reading strategies using Beanie Babies this year to help us become Super Readers! We will use our <u>C.A.F.E. Menu</u> (see attached). This month we will learn our first strategy for Comprehension. We will use <u>"Wondering Wolf"</u> to help <u>understand</u> what we read. Good readers ask themselves questions before, during and after they read (who, what, when, where, why, how?)

We will also begin reviewing our Daily 5 (see attached) procedures starting with 'Read to Self" by practicing independent reading, ways to read a book and choosing "Good Fit Books".

Writing:

This month we will work hard on setting up and reinforcing our Writers Workshop routines and begin writing personal narratives ("small moment" true stories.) We will also be working proper letter formation of upper and lowercase letters and neat printing.

Word Work/Sounds:

- Word endings: s, ed, ing
- Review our letter sounds
- Short Vowel sounds (a, e, I, o, u)

Math:

We will review **numbers to 10** including:

- proper printing of numerals 1-10
- counting sets up to 10
- comparing sets using words such as "more", "fewer", "the same as"
- subitize ("see in a snap") familiar arrangements of dots/objects up to 5.
- matching numerals to sets up to 10.

Math Unit: Patterning

Students will understand/explain:

- What a pattern is. A pattern repeats itself. We can make patterns using: color, size, shape, actions and sounds.
- <u>Tell you what their pattern is</u>. (square, circle, square, circle) or (clap, snap, stomp, clap, snap, stomp)
- -Reproduce/extend a pattern (copy a pattern and tell what comes next)
- -<u>Create repeating patterns using 2-4 elements</u>
 ABBABBABBABB **2 elements**



- 3 elements

red, blue, green, yellow, red, blue, green, yellow **– 4 elements**

While we are beginning our learning outcomes in all subject areas, there will be a strong focus this month on classroom/school expectations, along with routines and procedures in our classroom
