

# Kindergarten NewsletterSeptember – Mrs. Lyons



We will be working on the following outcomes this month:

### **Literacy:**

#### **Reading:**

We will learn many new reading strategies using Beanie Babies to help become Super Readers! We will use <u>C.A.F.E</u> strategies (see attached) with a strong focus on <u>Accuracy</u> (I can read the words). This month we will learn the <u>first way to read a book</u>: I can use pictures to read. Our first strategy: <u>"Eagle Eye"</u> reminds us to look at the pictures to help figure out what the words are.

We will also begin our Daily 5 (see attached) procedures starting with 'Read to Self" by practicing independent reading, ways to read a book and choosing "Good Fit Books".

<u>Jolly Phonics:</u> Students will learn letter sounds and names using actions and songs to familiar tunes. Please refer to the calendar to know which letter sounds we will be focusing on each day.

#### Writing:

<u>ABC Boom</u> – Students will learn proper letter formation using "strokes". Each pencil stroke has a sound and action. We will learn: **plop, vroom, boing, wee** and **shlang.** 

This month we will work hard on setting up and reinforcing our <u>Writers Workshop</u> routines. We will begin writing stories by **telling** about them, **drawing** a picture to match and adding **labels**. Proper pencil grip will also be a focus.

Word Work/Sounds: We will focus on learning the sounds, names and formation of: Ss, Aa, Tt, Ii, Pp,Nn

#### Math:

We will introduce **numbers to 5** including:

- proper printing of numerals 0-5
- counting sets up to 5 (by pointing and saying the corresponding number).
- relate a number to its matching set (5 and  $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$   $\bigcirc$
- show a given number using pictures and objects

#### Math Unit: Sorting and Patterning

Students will understand/explain/show:

- How he/she <u>can sort given or self-selected</u> <u>objects</u> in a variety of ways (by color, size, shape).
- <u>How he/she is sorting their items</u> (this is called a "sorting rule"). For ex: "My sorting rule is color."
- What a pattern is. A pattern repeats itself. We can make patterns using: color, size, shape, actions and sounds.
- Can copy, create and extend a given repeating pattern.
- <u>Tell you what their pattern is</u>. (square, circle, square, circle) or (clap, snap, stomp, clap, snap, stomp)

While we are beginning our learning outcomes in all subject areas, there will be a strong focus this month on classroom/school expectations, along with routines and procedures in our classroom
