

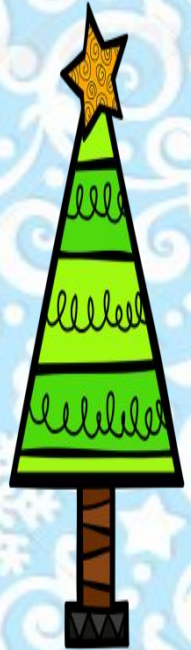

<b>Numeracy</b>	<p>In class we will be working on <b><u>estimation!</u></b></p> <p><u>At home you can help by asking your child estimation questions:</u></p> <p>Place 10 similar sized objects in a container. Place more objects (up to 60 or so) in a second container.</p> <p>Q: How many objects are in the container? Do you think there are 15, 20, 55, or 100 objects?</p> <p>Show your child a group of items and ask them to choose between two given estimates.</p> <p>Q: About how many do you think are here – 20 or 80? Why did you think that this is a good estimate?</p>
