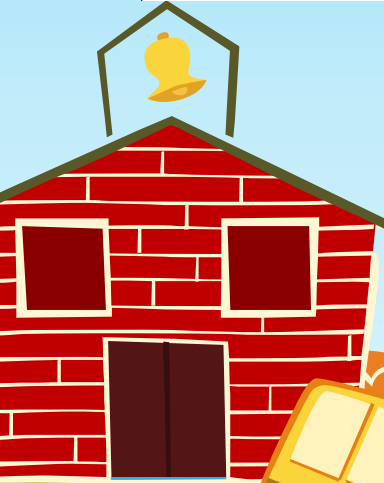

- Don't forget to Read 😊

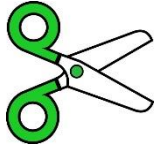
*Please read in English or French for 15minutes every night.*

- You can play “hangman” with the words (this will also help with spelling).
