

Grad Memo – Grads of 2018

Dates

Prom: June 19th, 7-10pm, *Maritime Club, CFB Gagetown*

Graduation Rehearsal: June 19th, 9:00 am at the AUC (Aitken University Centre), in Fredericton on the UNB Campus. Please arrive by 8:45am so you can find our seat and we can begin at 9:00 am sharp.

Graduation Awards Ceremony: The majority of our graduation awards are given out at the graduation rehearsal. All parents and guardians are encouraged to attend. To ensure you are there for the commencement of this ceremony, it is suggested that all parents and guardians and family members who wish to attend are at the Aitken Centre by 9:30am.

Graduation: June 20th, 7:30 pm at the AUC, in Fredericton on the UNB Campus. Doors will open at 6:00 pm. No invitation or tickets are required.

Graduation Events & Fees

Grad Fee: The grad fee for this year is \$120 and must be paid to attend graduation or any of the graduation activities that are held, commencing second semester. This fee covers the graduation composite, the rental of the Aitken Centre for graduation, Safe Grad, gowns etc..., basically all costs associated with graduation. Grad Fees are payable by cash, cheque (payable to Oromocto High School) or online through KEV software (instructions on reverse side of this memo). This memo is going out early so families can arrange to have the fee paid by January 31st, 2018. Students are to pay their fee to their AP teachers (unless you are paying online). If a parent wants to come in to the school to pay at the office they can. A receipt will be issued to you.

Graduation Dinner: Date and Time to be determined. The cost of this event is \$15 per graduate.

Student Council (SRC) Fee: All graduates must have also paid their Student Council (SRC) Fee of \$40.

Prom: The fee for prom is \$25 for the graduate, and \$25 for whoever they chose to accompany them, should they chose to bring someone. This will be payable to the prom committee, and the details will be announced in the spring. **Prom tickets can be purchased now online through KEV SchoolCashOnline.**

Valedictorian: The valedictorian for the Grad Class of 2018 will be chosen by a panel consisting of staff, a PSSC member and a student representative. Candidates interested in representing their classmates must fulfill the following criteria in order to put their name forward: 1) Have a cumulative academic average of at least 85% during the first three reporting periods of grade twelve, 2) Be approved by the office, 3) Must present to the panel to see how well you speak publically, and 4) agree to work with a teacher supervisor in preparation for your speech at graduation.

Yearbook: New this year, the yearbook will include coverage of the entire school year! The book will still arrive in June and include all activities, events, clubs, etc. until April. The difference this year will be an additional insert that will be mailed out over the summer to everyone who purchases a book. This insert will include year-end events such as the Sports Banquet, Citizenship Awards, and ALL grad events! **A special promotional price of \$50 will be on until Oct. 18 with an added incentive of 4 free activity icons with the purchase of personalization. That's \$17 worth of personalization for \$5.** Price goes up to \$55 Oct. 19 – Dec.15. Depending on availability, after Dec. 15 books will cost \$65 until sold out. Yearbooks are sold on a first come first served basis until the allotment is sold out. We cannot order more books once they are gone so please order early to avoid not being able to get one.

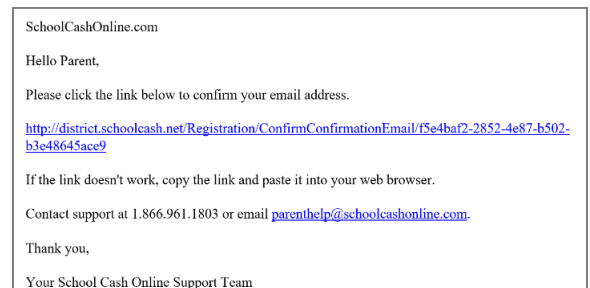
Step 1: Register

- If you have not registered, please go to the *School Cash Online* home page <https://district.schoolcashionline.com/> and select the "Get Started Today" option.
- Complete each of the three Registration Steps
*For Security Reasons your password, requires *8 characters*, *one uppercase letter*, *one lowercase letter* and a *number*.



Step 2: Confirmation Email

A registration confirmation email will be forwarded to you. Click on the link provided inside the email to confirm your email and *School Cash Online* account. The confirmation link will open the *School Cash Online* site prompting you to sign into your account. Use your email address and password just created with your account.





Step 3: Find Student

- This step will connect your children to your account.
- Enter the School Board Name. (Anglophone West School District)
 - Enter the School Name.
 - Enter Your Child's Student Number(if known), First Name, Last Name and Birth Date.
 - Select *Continue*.
 - On the next page confirm that you are related to the child, check in the Agree box and select *Continue*.
 - Your child has been added to your account.
