Each month the selected candidates pictures and biographies will be displayed in the school's lobby area and their names will be posted on the school sign and on the website. Our hope is to celebrate individual achievement by creating a culture of learning that values academic success, yet also celebrates many other aspects of student life.

Criteria may include, but is not limited to:

1. Academic performance – may include grades, class participation, shows marked improvement in performance, contributes, reliability, cooperative, works hard in all aspects
2. Character – displays one or some of the following: adaptability, compassion, kindness, honesty, initiative, loyalty, optimism, perseverance, respect, responsibility, and/or trustworthiness.
3. Behaviour – shows respect to peers, teachers, coaches, school staff, and those in authority, is well-mannered. Behaviour includes both inside and outside of the classroom.
4. Effort – works hard and is persistent, displays interest and eagerness in learning, helps others
5. Social Relationship – displays leadership, willingness to help peers, shows respect to others. Good citizenship or improvement in citizenship. Respectful to peers and adults.
6. Attendance – attends school regularly and arrives to school or practice on time or displays a positive improvement in attendance.
