No child can be admitted to a French Immersion Program if that child has attended a French school and is already able to function in French.

In Late French Immersion, Grades 6 through 8, the majority of subjects are taught in French resulting in a minimum of 70 per cent of instructional time in French over the course of the year. Students continue to have English Language Arts instruction to support development of first language skills.

In Grades 9 and 10, Late French Immersion students take a minimum of 50 per cent of their courses in French each school year and in Grades 11 and 12, students are required to take a minimum of 25 per cent of their courses in French each school year.
