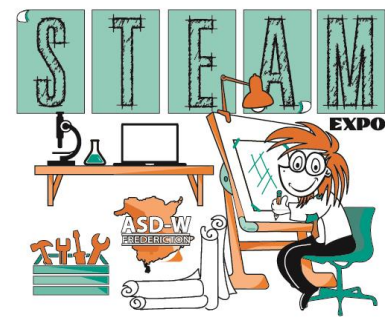


# ASD-West **STEAM EXPO**
