REPORTING ON SUSPECTED CRIMINAL ACTIVITY IN SCHOOLS

Category: Health and Safety

Effective: August 2017

Policy Statement

Reporting criminal activity should not be interpreted as an alternative to disciplinary action imposed by school authorities.

Procedures

- 1. The Principal shall report to law enforcement authorities acts on school property involving suspected criminal activity.
- 2. The Principal or designate shall endeavor to notify the parent(s)/guardian(s) of any student(s) alleged to have been involved in the activity.
- 3. The Principal or designate <u>shall</u> request that the law enforcement agency(ies) wait for the parent(s)/guardian(s) to arrive before interviewing the student(s).
- 4. The Principal shall document reports made to law enforcement authorities.
