



REPORTING ON SUSPECTED CRIMINAL ACTIVITY IN SCHOOLS

Category: Health and Safety

Effective: August 2017

Policy Statement

Reporting criminal activity should not be interpreted as an alternative to disciplinary action imposed by school authorities.

Procedures

1. The Principal shall report to law enforcement authorities acts on school property involving suspected criminal activity.
2. The Principal or designate shall endeavor to notify the parent(s)/guardian(s) of any student(s) alleged to have been involved in the activity.
3. The Principal or designate shall request that the law enforcement agency(ies) wait for the parent(s)/guardian(s) to arrive before interviewing the student(s).
4. The Principal shall document reports made to law enforcement authorities.
