APPENDIX B – Sexual Assault Response Protocol Flowchart

CONSIDER: Is there an imminent threat to the survivor, other students, or school personnel? Are there any physical injuries or medical Establish a trusting relationship by listening, accepting and supporting. Imminent Threat? CALL 911 AND FOLLOW APPROPRIATE EMERGENCY PROCEDURES. Physical Injuries/Medical Risks? Take immediate action to address the injury consistent with standard practices. If

RESPONSE:

- Remain responsive, supportive, and open.
- Avoid asking probing or investigative questions. Avoid language that blames or judges survivor's actions before, during, or after the incident (e.g.: "Why did you...", "Why weren't you...").
- Say: "Thank you for telling me." "I am glad you have trusted me."
- Maintain an accurate record of the disclosure.
- Contact a sexual assault support person and/or school administrator (as appropriate)
- Contact Department of Social Development, Child Protection (1-888-992-2873).
- Contact parent/guardian if appropriate.

SUPPORT:

- Evaluate risk to survivor, other students, and staff.
- Provide support to maintain a positive learning environment.
- Provide support and information to families of the survivor, student who offends and others as appropriate (information could include school and district policies, possible interventions and procedures).
- Offer appropriate referrals.

Student Who Offends in School?

- Consult survivor regarding safety, security and positive learning environment.
- Consider options to accommodate education needs of survivor and student who offends.
- Consult and support families of survivor and student who offends if appropriate.
- Monitor peers to ensure safe learning environment.

- Consult survivor regarding safety, security and positive learning environment.
- Consult and support family of survivor if appropriate.
- Monitor peers to ensure safe learning environment.
