

Policy Statement

A school administrator or teacher is authorized to detain a student for disciplinary reasons, for a reasonable period, in accordance with established procedures.

Procedures

- In the event that an elementary walking student is to be detained beyond fifteen (15) minutes after the normal closing time, the parent/guardian shall be notified. The parent/guardian of a middle school walking student shall be notified if the student is to be detained beyond thirty (30) minutes.
- 2. The Principal or designate shall notify the parent/guardian of a bus student one day in advance, or arrange by phone contact with parent for same day detention, and ensure that alternate transportation has been arranged if that student has a detention to serve after the normal departure time of the bus.
- 3. Mass detention aimed at unspecified individuals or groups is not recommended.
- 4. Students who are detained shall not be left alone during their detention. Their supervision shall be provided, or arranged for, by the teacher or administrator who detains them.
- 5. No student shall be required to serve a detention depriving that student of a minimum of twenty (20) minutes for lunch.
- 6. After school detention on one day shall be limited to no more than one hour beyond regular instructional time.
- 7. Whenever possible, detention time should be used as an opportunity for academic activities.
