Numeracy	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Cut apart the number cards included in your home learning package. Put the numbers in order from 1 to 10. As a challenge try 1 to 20. Can you do it backwards?</li> </ul>
Wellness	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>The sun is shining today. Be sure to spend some time outside playing or going for a walk.</li> </ul>

## Tuesday

### Literacy

- Re-read our word families.
- Using the paperclip provided complete the –ill word family activity.
- Choose four of the sight words. Can you put them in ABC (alphabetical) order?
- Read a book from home or Storyline Online.

### Numeracy

- A number path is a line of numbers that create a path when found in order. Complete the number path activity page. Each box shows ways to represent numbers. Colour the box that represents one at the start position, move to a connecting box that shows 2, then 3, then 4 and so on to make a path to the finish line.

### Wellness

- We have been home from school for a while now. Talk to someone about what you like about being home from school and what you miss about school.

## Wednesday

### Literacy

- Practice spelling the –ill and –ug word families. On Friday I (or your family) will be asking you to spell some of these words. We will also be asking you to print the sentence: **The bug is on a hill.**

### Exploration Time

- Tomorrow is Remembrance Day. In your home learning package are some resources from Veterans Affairs Canada for you to enjoy.
- Have mom or dad read pages 2 and 3 of the newspaper to you about how helpful animals were during war time.
- Complete the Tales of Animals in War activity. Attached to the activity are animal pictures for you to cut and paste, and a small poster for mom or dad to discuss with you when completing the activity.

### Remembrance Day

Take some time to think about how lucky we are to live in Canada.

## Friday

### Literacy

- Get you're your word family dictation page ready. When we meet on TEAMS have a pencil handy. If you are unable to meet have mom or dad call out 5 words from each word family for you to spell. Don't forget the sentence!
- Over the next couple of days work on the 'I miss school!' writing activity. Bring it back to school on the first day back.

### Numeracy

- Patterning – Using the Pete the Cat patterning page colour a pattern that is indicated. It might be an AB, ABC, AABB or a create your own pattern.

### Wellness

- When we return to school the weather will be very different than when we left. Make a list of outdoor clothing you will need in your bookbag to stay warm.
