
Homework May 17th – 20th

- 2. Math Please continue to review all of your math fact cards. Continue to practice counting by 2's, 5's and 10's. How high can you count to?
- 3. Spelling This week we are continuing our focus on the 'no excuse' spelling words. This is the last half of the words. These are words that should be spelled correctly 100% of the time at the end of grade one. This will be the last week for a dictation test.
- 4. Writer's Workshop: This week, the students will work on an independent writing piece at school. This writing sample will take a few days to complete. It will be an "Ouch" story. Help your child think of a time when they got hurt and practice telling the story using some of the following prompts: What happened? When did it happen? Where were you? Who were you with? How did you feel? How did it end? Did you have to go to the hospital? (Do not write the story at home, this is a discussion to help with their writing at school.) I will be sending the completed piece home for you to see.

- 1. RAH-RAH Read the second book in your folder. Is the book fiction or non fiction? How do you know?
- 2. Spelling practice spelling the grade one "No Excuse" words.
- 3. Math Practice your math fact cards.
- 4. Sight Words Practice reading all of your sight words.

Thursday

- 1. RAH-RAH Reread one of the books in your folder. Remember to return your books and your folder tomorrow so that I can change them.
- Math Review all of your math fact cards. Find 5 objects in your house. Put them in order from shortest to longest.
