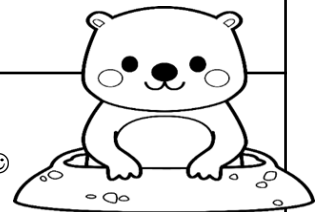
### Monday
