Dear Parents,

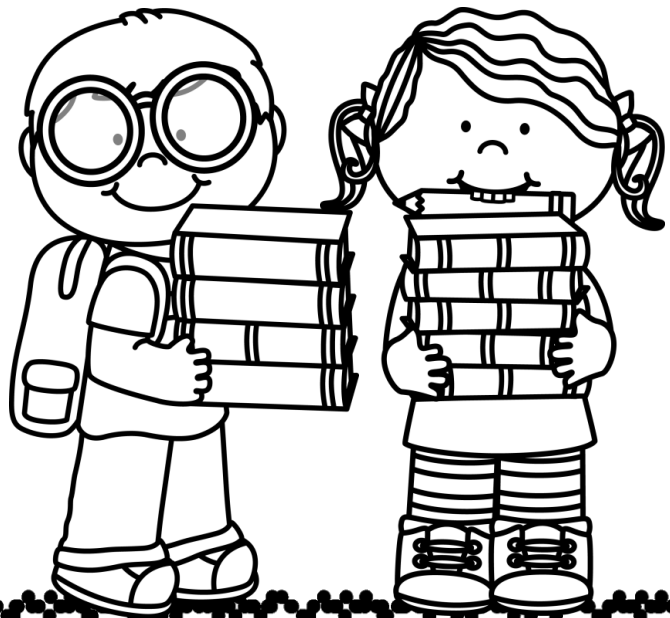
Today we are going to begin our RAH RAH (Read At Home) program.

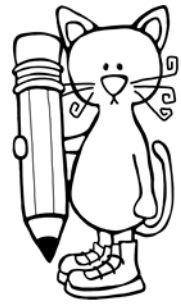
After the books are read, your child is to lightly colour in the book titles on the recording page. This will ensure that your child will get different books the next week.
