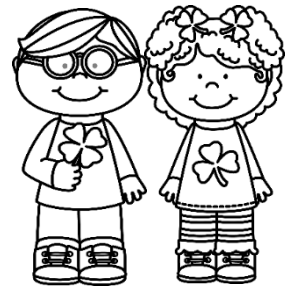


Homework – Mar. 15th – 18th
