We will be working on the following curriculum outcomes this month:

Literacy

Reading:

Comprehension (understanding what we read) - We'll review all strategies learned so far. •We'll continue to use what we've learned to answer multiple choice questions on reading comprehension texts. Accuracy (reading unknown words correctly) - We'll review all strategies.

Fluency (reading smoothly with expression) - We'll continue to learn about non-fiction texts. Expand our Vocabulary (learning new words) - We'll review all strategies.

Writing:

We'll continue "how to" writing and learn about joining words.

Math

Math Facts:

- Subtraction strategies

Operations:

- Developing personal strategies to subtract 2-digit numbers
- Creating and solving subtraction word problems

Measurement:

- Compare/order objects by length, height, distance around and mass using nonstandard units, and make statements of comparison.
- Measure length using multiple copies of a unit; using a single copy of a unit.
- Demonstrate that changing the orientation of an object does not alter the measurements.
