

## Introduction to NBTAP

NBTAP connects Grade 10 and 11 high school students with skilled trades employers in New Brunswick for paid summer work placements in their region.



## Creating a **Student Account**



#### Before you can apply, you have to activate your account. Here's how:

1. Click 'Apply'.






1. Click 'Login'

## There are 6 steps to complete your application NOTE:

- When a number is red: It means the step has not been started.
- When a number is yellow: It means the step is partially complete.
- · When a number is green: It means the step is complete, and can still be edited.
- When a number is grey: It means the step cannot be completed yet, or cannot be edited after completion.





#### Introduction

NBTAP is a pre-apprentice program that connects high school students with New Brunswick skilled trades employers. Employers identify skilled trades jobs they will need to fill in the future and NBTAP helps them recruit, and prepare to train and mentor interested and qualified students. NBTAP Student Apprentices learn practical skilled trades and workplace skills with skilled trades mentors over 2 or 3 paid summer work terms.

The availability of skilled trades work placements in each region depends on the needs identified by local employers. There is egg guarantee there will be a placement available in your location that matches the skilled trades interest(s) you have chosen.

## Be sure to read the instructions carefully.

#### Instructions

Thank you for your interest in NBTAP. To apply you will need to complete all 6 steps online.

- Once you submit steps 1-5, your parent/guardian will receive an email with a button to click to complete step 6 with you.
- . Once step 6 is submitted, your NBTAP Consent Form will be emailed to your parent/guardian and to you.
- · You must print your NBTAP Consent Form for you and your parent/guardian to sign and date.
- By January 17, 2019 you must take the signed NBTAP Consent Form to your NBTAP School Champion. This will authorize your school to release your sensester 1 report card and school attendance records to NBTAP.
- Your school champion will forward your school records to NBTAP on your behalf.

#### Note: Your application is not considered complete until:

- 1. You have completed all 6 steps online.
- 2. Both of your NBTAP Reference Forms have been submitted online.
- 3. You have given your signed NBTAP Consent Form to your NBTAP School Champion.


To be considered for a NBTAP placement, your application must be completed in full by January 17, 2019.





Your reference people must be able to evaluate specific skills, attitudes, and behaviours that you have demonstrated in the past. They must also be able to comment on your aptitude for hands on activities or project-based learning and your ability to meet employer expectations. Click here to view a sample copy of the NBTAP fleference Form. Make sure you enter the correct email address for both people you asked to complete the reference form.

## You must get 2 references:

 from a teacher and
 from someone who knows you from your professional or community experience



When you click 'Submit and Send Step 6 - Parent/Guardian Information', two things will happen:


- Reference forms will be sent to the 2 people you have asked to provide references for you.


