GRADUATION 2017 INFORMATION

- Grad invitations will be available on June 12th for those grads who have paid all of their grad fees. Please see office for fees owing.
- Grad Class Breakfast and "Pass the Torch" Tuesday, June 6th starting at 8:30 in the cafeteria.
- Grad gowns will be handed out starting on June 15th. All fees must be paid to receive your grad gown, cap and tassel. Caps and tassels will be given the morning of graduation rehearsal as well as honor cords. The cap and tassel and honor cord is yours to keep; the gown must be returned after graduation. Honor cords are determined based on a year end, 85% average of all grade 12 courses.
- Graduation Banquet: Monday, June 19th at 6:00. This is for graduates and teachers only. This is held at the Tobique Lions' Center. Meal will start at 6:00 sharp.
- Prom: Friday, June 16th. Grand March is at 8:00. If you are participating in the parade, be at the Welcome Center at the park by 7:00. We will get your escort's name when you arrive at the school, or if you can give the name to Mrs. Corey ahead of time, that would help. Graduates will enter the building through the cafeteria doors. Those coming to view the Grand March are to enter through the outside gym doors, next to the soccer field. Cost is \$2.00. The dance is for graduates, their escorts and parents ONLY. There is reserved seating for parents to watch the grand march in front of the bleachers; all others watch from the bleachers.
- Graduation Practice: Tuesday, June 20th at 9:00am. This is a mandatory practice. All grads must attend. It is very important that you know how to march in, who you are paired with, where your seat on stage is, etc, so please be here for practice and don't be late. It should last about an hour. Gowns will be distributed after practice, if you have not received yours already. All fees must be paid to receive your gown.
- Graduation: Tuesday, June 20th at 6:00. Please be at the school by 5:30. All grads need to gather in the culinary tech room to get your rose(girls) and

boutonnieres (boys). Do not wear jeans or flip-flops. The Superintendent Mr. David McTimoney and Premier Brian Gallant will be in attendance.

- Grad gowns should be returned immediately after the ceremony to the Physics lab. Please let us know if you wish to borrow for a period of time.
 Do not leave the gown laying around; return it so your name is checked off.
- Graduation Invitations: You will receive 8 invitations per graduate. Two of these have red reserved tickets for the front rows (parents) and six blue reserved tickets for the remaining seats. These people can sit in the remaining chairs on the floor. Please have your guests bring these tickets to graduation to hand to the ushers so they know where to sit them at the ceremony. The invitation is also the program. All other guests without invitations can sit in the bleachers first-come, first-seated.
