Dressing for School for Warmer Days

- Students are asked to wear appropriate school clothing. This may not necessarily be in keeping with today's fashions; however, everyone is expected to dress sensibly and modestly. The following guidelines should be kept in mind:
 - Tops must have backs and fronts that completely cover undergarments. The chest must be covered.

- Shorts and skirts are to be of length no shorter than mid-thigh.
- Pants and trousers are to be worn properly fastened at the waist to ensure that undergarments do not show.
- Clothing should not have any offensive slogans, or advertisement of drugs or alcohol.

Application for Out-Of-Catchment School Zone for 2022-2023 School Year

- Parents / Guardians who wish to request placement in a school other than the school zone of your residence will need to complete the Request for Intra-District School Placement Form, stating your reason(s) for your request.
- Permission to place children outside their school zone is only given on a year-to-year basis. You must re-apply each year to request permission. It is important that you do not put this off failure to apply may result in your child attending their catchment zoned school.
- Parents / Guardians will need to provide their own transportation to and from school for their child.
- Please contact the school so that we can provide you with Inter-District School Placement Application Form we can do this electronically or by paper. Grades K-5 School Supplies Information for 2022-2023

- For your convenience, Townsview School will be offering parents/guardians the opportunity to purchase a
- School Supply Pack for the 2022-2023 school year. We encourage parents to take advantage of this opportunity. This will be offered to K-5 students only.
- The cost of the school pack is \$57.75 and will include all the supplies. required, with the exception of book bag, lunch bag and indoor sneakers.
- Payment can be made by cash, paying by School Cash Online: https://district.schoolcashonline.com/ or by cheque. Cheques are to be made payable to Townsview School, (please do not post-date these cheques).
 - Our Pre-K students will not be able to pay for their school supplies by School Cash Online they will only be able to pay by cash and/or cheque. This is because our Pre-K students will not be registered into our school registration system until August, 2022.
 - → There will be a school supply order form this will be sent home to families by Wednesday, June 1st. This is when School Cash Online will be activated to receive payment
 - → If parents pay for school supplies vis School Cash Online it is important that they complete the school supply form and send back to the school, so that we will have a record of you ordering the school supplies. School Cash Online does not tell Wanda (in the office) what grade level you have paid for, it only shows that you paid. this is an important piece for us to know so that your child receives their school supplies at the start of the school year.
- For those families who do not wish to purchase their school supplies through the school, we will be sending home your child's school supply list in their final report card envelope on the last day of school, which will be Friday, June 24th. The school supply list for each grade level will be posted on our school website:
