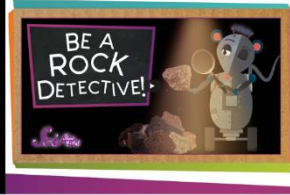

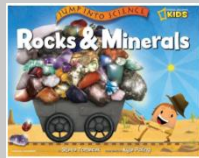

The answer does not have a 9 in the ones place.

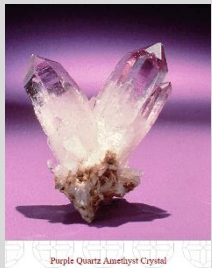
