Collect, Sort & Pattern Collect 10 objects from your backyard. Sort them by color, shape and size. Use some (or all) of your objects to create your own pattern.	Will it Float or Sink? Find a puddle of water. Test objects to see if they float or sink. 	Longer, Shorter or About the Same? Choose a twig about the length of your hand and use this tool to measure things in your backyard.
Guess my missing part? -Place a collection of 10 small items in your hand. (marbles, coins, rocks, macaroni) -Put your hands behind your back then show your partner one of your hands with some of the collection in it. -Your partner must decide how many are still in the hidden hand. -Challenge: When ready play with a larger collection up to 20 items. 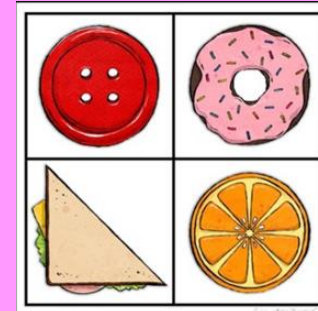

Look at the pictures below and choose which item you think does not belong. Share your thinking with someone and explain why. Now ask a family member which one they think does not belong and why?

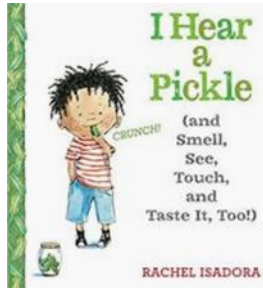
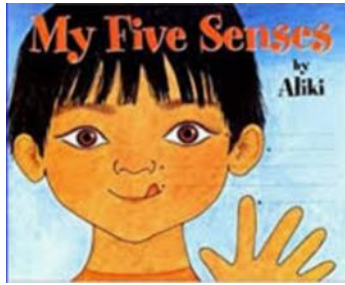


Making Words

Make a chart on your paper that includes the 5 senses and 3 boxes for each sense. Go outside and explore. Use pictures and words to record your findings on your chart as you are outside

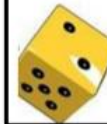
