Hello Grade 3-5 CCS families,

We are sure that you are finding our new situation just as hard to believe as we are. The Department of Education and Early Childhood Development recommends about an hour of home learning for students in Grades 3-5 each day. All activities will be posted on the school website under "Class Announcements > Grades 3, 4, 5" on Mondays. For those that have provided an email address we will also send an email with a link to the website where they are posted. Learning activities will be posted as a "Menu" - options from which you and your student(s) can choose throughout the week to work on. Activities will be available to all students regardless of their Grade, start with the first tasks and then try the challenges if you can!

This is a great time for your child to do some self-guided learning. If your child has a special interest, let them explore this. This can be anything! Sports, hobbies, animals, places - investigate, research, watch documentaries, let them make a presentation to share what they learned. This is also a great time to learn life skills and responsibilities- have them help at home (meal planning and cooking, laundry, pets, grocery lists). And remember.....Let them PLAY. Learning is still happening while they play and play is important for many reasons such as using their imagination, having fun, and feeling safe.

This is a difficult time for everyone and we are here to support you in any way that we can. We miss the students so much and we can't wait to be reunited whenever that may be!

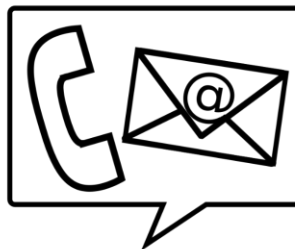
