

# **Math Read Aloud**

Get out your measuring tools and a bowl and start Math class!

- Make your slime.
- You can make half of the first recipe. Get an adult to help you. The ratio is just 1:1.
- I usually add a bit less water with the first recipe.
- If your slime is not thick enough, just add more corn starch.



# Oobleck Recipe

- 1. 1 cup of cornstarch in bowl.
- 2. Put in food coloring (green preferred)
- Put in one cup of water to make thick.
  - Mix ingredients together in bowl.
  - Pour in sandwich bags for students!

#### Materials:

- 1 part water
- 1 part glue
- 1 part liquid starch
- 1 drop of food coloring

Popsicle stick

#### Steps:

- 1. Mix water and glue in cup. Mix it really well.
- 2. Add 1 drop of food coloring Mix.
- 3. Add liquid starch. Mix.
- 4. Have fun!


# Other areas of interest/learning experiences
