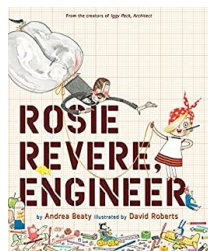

Make a fun fort with blankets and pillows or whatever you can find to snuggle in to read.

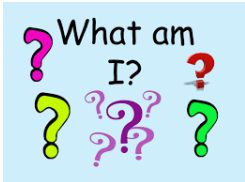
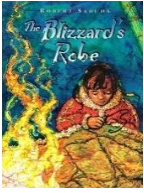

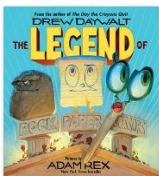

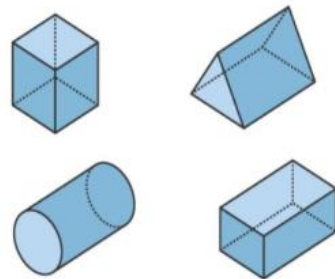

Cross out the number that has the same digit in the ones place as in the tens place.


