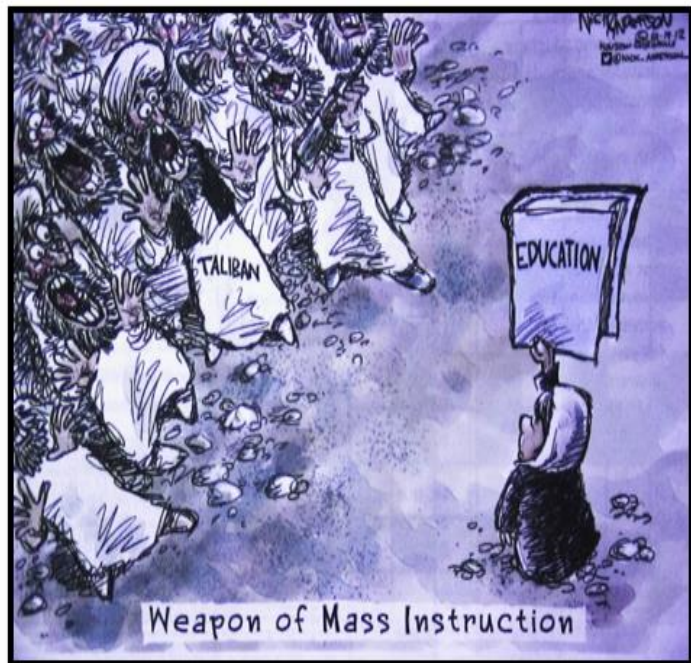


## Evaluate: Malala- "Unbreakable: One Girl Changing the World" Lesson
