Please drop into the school to fill out some paperwork to register your child for kindergarten next year. Please remember to have your child's Medicare card, Immunization record and Birth Certificate.



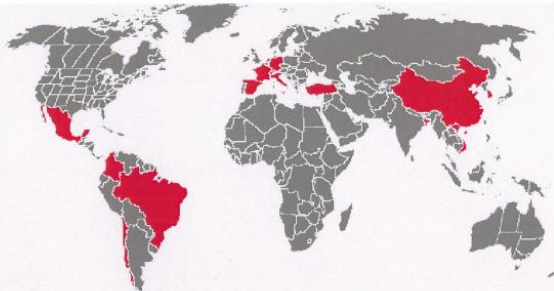
## BECOME A HOST FAMILY
