Dairy Farmers of New Brunswick Memorial Scholarship

Two scholarships - Applicant must reside in NB and be enrolled in a university degree program related to agriculture or the dairy industry including, but not limited to plant and animal science, ag engineering, veterenary science, ag economists, etc... Applicants must write a 300 - 500 word essay about future plans and how they relate to agriculture. Value: \$1000

Dairy Farmers of New Brunswick Scholarship

Applicant must reside in NB and be accepted in an approved technician or technology program relating to agriculture or the dairy industry including, but not limited to, plant and animal science, farm management, farm technology, field technology., etc... Applicants must write a 300 - 500 word essay about future plans and how they relate to agriculture. Value: \$1000.

Special consideration given to veteran's children accepted at a technical school or university. Awarded on the basis of financial need and scholastic record. Value: \$250.00
