Individual Planning

-help students plan, monitor, and manage their own learning as well as their personal and career development.

- **Individual Appraisal:** Counsellors work with teachers and students analyzing and evaluating students' abilities, interests, skills and achievement.

- **Individual Advisement:** Counsellors and teachers work with students, using personal, social, educational, career and labour market information in planning personal, educational and occupational goals. The involvement of students, parents and the school in planning is critical. Parent-student communication is important.

-**Placement:** Counsellors, teachers and parents assist students in making the transition from school to work or post-secondary school.

Your Role

- Communicate with your child about their interests and values.
- Research options together (view post secondary websites)
- Please consider campus tours and/or open houses (ex. see next slide)
- Encourage them to ask questions to the post secondary institutions. They are learning to self-advocate and some of them are nervous about doing this.
- Read the handouts that are sent with students.
- View the CNHS website for updates and information (there is a useful list of guiding questions posted on the website)

Student Responsibility

- Research admissions requirements and application deadlines for the programs they are interested in Ex. NBCC Ex. Business
- Request transcripts at least a week in advance
- Request letters of reference at least two weeks in advance
- Check website frequently: scholarship updates and other important information
- Students that come with specific questions about a university or college, we will assist them with where to locate the information themselves.
- Students need to learn to self advocate and research themselves (because universities won't talk to us).
- We will not fill out application forms for students, however, will review the forms with them after they have completed it.
