Practice multiplication facts.

Draw a game board 5 rows of 4.

Decide 2 multiplication type facts you want to work on and print them on the top of your paper. Ex: $X 4$ $X 6$

In the squares print all the products 0×4 to 9×4 and 0×6 to 9×6 . Using a deck of cards 1-9 and queens being 0, players will take turns flipping over a card. If they flip over a 2 they can decide to multiply 2×4 or 2×6 and cover the product. Next player's turn. First player to get 3 in a row wins.

Canvas, cardboard or thick paper

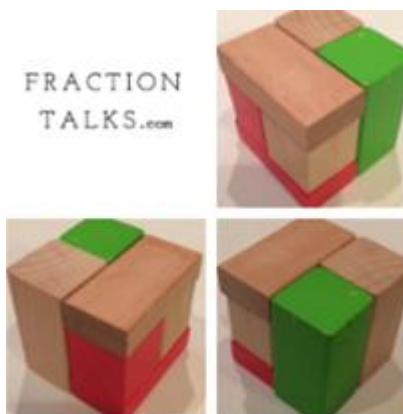
*Heat up the crayon to melt the wax to create your art piece!
