

## **Natural Actions and Gestures**

## 16 gestures by 16 months

Children naturally use gestures starting around 9 months. The development of gestures predicts a child's language skills 2 years later.

Specific gestures will depend on your family and culture and the gestures that you have used around your baby. We know that all toddlers should have **16 gestures by 16 months**.

## Gestures may develop in the order below:

s head "no"	S	9 months
s nead no	5	9 months

Gives

10 months Reaches

Raises arms

11 months Shows you something

Waves

12 months Points with open hand or taps to tell you something

13 months Claps

Blows kiss

14 months Points with index finger

15 months Nods head "yes"

16 months Other symbolic gestures like "shrugs shoulders", "high 5"
