



Dinosaur Fossils

- Salt dough (see recipe below)
- Small plastic dinosaur toy
- Circle cookie cutter or cup



1. Roll dough, making sure it is more than half the thickness of your dinosaur.
2. Use a cookie cutter/cup to cut out a circle.
3. Press your dinosaur into the dough and remove.
4. Bake at 200 F until dry. The amount of time needed to bake your creations depends on size and thickness; thin flat ornaments may only take 45-60 minutes, thicker creations can take 2-3 hours or more. You can also air dry.
5. Paint your fossils with regular acrylic paint. Seal the paint with varnish or polyurethane spray.

Salt Dough

- 1 cup salt
 - 2 cups all purpose flour
 - 1 cup luke warm water
1. In a large bowl mix salt and flour.
 2. Gradually stir in water. Mix well until it forms a doughy consistency.
 3. With your hands form a ball with your dough and knead it for at least 5 minutes. The longer you knead your dough the smoother it will be.
 4. To color your dough add food coloring to water.
