



## Shaving Cream Easter Eggs

- Hard boiled eggs
- White shaving cream
- Muffin tin or small containers
- Food colouring
- Tongs
- Paper towel



1. Fill containers with shaving cream. Add a few drops of food colouring to each.
2. Stir in food colouring. Add a few drops of second color; drag stirrer through cream to add swirls and create designs.
3. Submerge your eggs in the colored cream and let sit for 15 to 20 minutes (the longer they are in the cream, the brighter the colour will be).
4. Remove eggs from dye with tongs, and gently wipe clean with a paper towel.

## Easter Bunny Canvas Art

- Small canvas
- Washable craft paint
- Q-tips
- Bunny sticker/window cling
- Paint brush



Place the bunny sticker on the canvas. Let your child have fun painting their canvas (you can paint over the sticker). While the paint is still tacky, peel off the sticker. Dip the q-tip in water and then wipe away any paint that is on your bunny. *From: thediyvillage.com*

### Funny Bunny

*Here is a bunny with ears so funny,
