



Cupcake Liner Flowers

- Cupcake liners
- Glue
- Construction paper
- Popsicle sticks (green—colour if needed)
- Scissors



Help your child cut leaves from construction paper. Glue popsicle sticks onto paper for flower stems. Flatten cupcake liners and glue to the popsicle stick. Glue on leaves.

Spring sensory Bottles

- Plastic bottles
- Fresh flowers or plastic flowers/butterflies/bugs etc.
- Water
- Hot glue (optional)



Take a nature walk and pick different flowers, leaves and twigs as you go. Place a few flowers in a plastic bottle and fill with water. Screw cap on tight. Replace flowers when they begin to wilt.
OR fill your bottle with fake flowers and glue the cap on for long lasting fun.

Here is a Beehive

*Here is the beehive, (point to clenched fist)
Where are the bees?
Hidden away where nobody sees
(hide fist behind your back)
Watch and you'll see them come out of their hives,
(bring out fingers quickly one by one)
One, two, three, four, five...
Buzz, buzz, buzz! (gently tickle your child)*

Plant a Little Seed

*Plant a little seed in the cold, cold ground.
(pretend to plant)
Out comes the yellow sun, big and round.
(put arms above head like the sun)
Down come the raindrops soft and slow.
(wiggle fingers to the ground)
Up comes the flower grow, grow, grow!
(slowly stand up with each "grow")*
