



Watermelon Mosaic

- Paper plate
- Pink/red and green paper squares
- Black marker/paint
- Glue



Glue the green squares along the outside edge of the paper plate. Cover the inside of the plate with glue and stick pink or red paper all over. Draw or paint seeds on top.

Super Bubbles/Inside a Bubble

- 1 1/2—2 gallons of distilled water
- 1 bottle of original Dawn dish soap (blue)
- 1 bottle of glycerin or 2 cups of corn syrup

Bubble Solution: Add ingredients and stir gently (do not make foam).

Inside a Bubble: Lay a hula hoop in the bottom of a clean, small kiddie pool. Pour enough solution in to cover the hoop. Have your child stand or sit inside the hoop (be careful it's very slippery). Raise the hoop up around them (this works best if the air is still and the weather is not too humid).
